② MS 232 - Homiletics (Developing and Delivery Sermons)

Course Description:

The course is based on the premise that what we preach determines how we preach. You learn how to exegete the text in preparation for preaching. First, students work with texts that demand the use of skills from three basic genre strategies in biblical interpretation: poetic, narrative, and didactic analysis. Attention is given to the classical (historical, material, cultural, lexical) and contemporary (pre-understanding, biblical theology, application) aspects of interpretation based on the Dialectical Method. Second, student use the Basic Sermon Outline on page 166 “*Companion to the Dialectical Method of Biblical Exegesis*” to develop **text – theme – introduction – body – conclusion**.
